Located in one of Bodrum's most tranquil bays, Tilkicik, Rose Beach Garden Villa embraces the endless Mediterranean sea and sky.

Originally designed as a private residence, the villa underwent renovations in 2024 to transform into a luxury rental villa. Owners Rose H. Bilge and her husband, who also run the Rose Beach Garden boutique hotel, collaborated with Selin Persentili Aral of SP Branding for the project's conceptual branding and strategy. Meanwhile, Bodrum Nomads, led by Ebru Kılıç and Yasemin Aksoy, left their signature in the villa's interior design and styling.

A Four-Story Mediterranean Haven

The four-story Rose Beach Garden Villa consists of two partially connected buildings and terraced gardens. The ground floors house two living rooms, two kitchens, two pantries, and shared outdoor spaces, including a fire pit corner, multiple seating areas, sunbathing zones, a pool, and a bar. The second and third floors accommodate bedrooms and bathrooms, while the top-floor terraces, designed as massage and relaxation areas, offer the ultimate retreat with breathtaking sea views.

Stepping out of the main building toward the sea, you'll pass through tiered gardens dedicated to yoga, reading, and sunbathing, leading to the villa's private pier and crystal-clear turquoise waters. The only sound you'll hear? Silence—because this place is truly a hidden gem.

A New Definition of Luxury in Bodrum

Luxury in Bodrum goes beyond conventional definitions. It is about collaborations with prestigious brands, an appreciation for art, comfort, sensory experiences, sustainability, and local values. Selin Persentili Aral collaborated with Ebru Kilic and Yasemin Aksoy for the interior design and styling; as well as with brands such as Homemade Aromatherapy, 3rd Culture, Hita Concept, Yargıcı Homeworks, Assouline, Frenchouse, Flamant, Nude, Yastık by Rifat Özbek, So Boho by Chakra, Gibi, Lamare Living, and Zara Home. The villa's newly installed aluminum joinery was completed in partnership with Linea Rosa.

Spread across one acre, the villa's 400-square-meter open spaces ensure seamless flow between indoor and outdoor areas. Naturally cooled by Yalıkavak's signature breeze, the twin buildings house seven sea-view bedrooms, each with a private balcony and en-suite bathroom. The pool, located next to the bar area, features a jet system and is chlorine-free. The lower and upper gardens, as well as the rooftop terrace with a jacuzzi, serve as spaces for meditation, yoga, and personalized wellness sessions. Powered entirely by solar energy, the villa embraces an eco-conscious lifestyle, focusing on sustainable and locally sourced products.

The earthy tones of the villa's corporate color palette extend into the interior spaces. Olive green, shades of blue, turmeric, saffron, and bursts of bougainvillea pink, accompanied by oak wood, create a harmonious blend. The interplay of stone textures, wood, and linen fabrics finds its way into the ikat or çintemani-patterned pillows and handcrafted ceramic necklaces. The aesthetic, a fusion of ethno-nomad and contemporary styles, reflects the chic Mediterranean spirit that honors local craftsmanship.
